



At Home Internet Access Options (2016-17)

Ceres Unified School District has made it a priority to provide every student with a mobile device to access digital instructional materials and reliable Internet access at school. However, outside of school, a “digital divide” prevents some of our students from accessing the Internet for research and supplemental web-based materials. Although access to these resources may not be required for student homework assignments, CUSD is providing options to families to help close this gap.

Option 1: Residential Internet Providers - Families can sign up with an Internet Service Provider at standard consumer rates with no access limitations, eligibility requirements, greater Internet speeds, and a variety of other service offerings available.

Option 2: Low Cost Internet Access

There are two “low cost” options available to CUSD families sponsored by EveryoneOn.org

- 1) **NEW AT&T Access program** – at home Wi-Fi **10 Mbps for \$10 per month** (No install, modem fee, or contracts). **Eligibility** – At least one individual in household must participate in U.S. Supplemental Nutrition Assistance (SNAP), Cal Fresh, or SSI program.
 - 2) **Basic Internet** – mobile Wi-Fi “hot spot”. **Plans start at \$10 per month** and provide unlimited 3G (3 Mbps or less) and limited 4G access. One-time equipment fee of \$50. **Eligibility** – anyone can sign up, no income requirements, or contracts.

Option 3: No Cost Internet Access - CUSD would provide one Internet Wi-Fi “hot spot” per household for CUSD-issued student Chromebook access only. All connected devices (limit of 4) are filtered with video, media, and audio streaming services completely blocked. Only educational content and approved web sites will be accessible.
